



## Early Years of Teaching Awards Information Session for Primary and Secondary Nominations

Nominations are now open for the 2020 Early Years of Teaching Awards, conducted annually by the Guild. There are two categories of Award, one for a Secondary (7-12) teacher, and one for a Primary (K-6) teacher. **Only teachers in their second or third year of teaching are eligible for nomination.**

The Awards are now in their twenty-seventh year. Each year they have been highly valued by the recipients, who have all been outstanding new members of the teaching profession. The two winners will receive a cash prize of one thousand and five hundred dollars (\$1500) and a Certificate of Excellence. The presentations will be made at our Awards Evening and Dinner on Friday 23 October, along with a suite of other Awards made by the Guild.


## Complimentary Parking:
